This letter is in response to your August 13, 2020, request for review of the decision to dismiss your complaint against the City of Greensboro Housing and Urban Development (HUD) (Respondent). In your letter, you requested a review of the investigative case file.

The investigative records reflect that you filed a complaint against Respondent on July 15, 2020, alleging that Respondent withheld housing assistance in retaliation for reporting Section 8 and HUD violations. The Atlanta Regional Office conducted an investigation and determined that your allegation was not covered under Section 11(c) of the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 (OSH Act), 29 U.S.C. §660(c). Consequently, your complaint was dismissed on July 29, 2020.

The Directorate of Whistleblower Protection Programs (DWPP) completed a review of the investigative case file and determined your complaint was properly dismissed for lack of coverage. Please note that this is the final determination of the Secretary of Labor; your case is now closed.
